## TECHNIQUE INSTRUCTIONS

Page 21

In the first visual the "sl1" should be pointing to the first stitch on the LEFT needle, not on the right needle.

Page 27

Linen Stitch Selvedge Edge - Odd number of Stitches  
The boundary box of the chart is wrong. It should be surrounding only two stitches, not three.

Page 69

To begin, loosely cast on an odd number of stitches with DC using a circular needle or double-pointed needles. **Turn work.**

Set-Up Row (DC): \*p1, sl1yof; rep from \*, end with p1. Do not turn, slide work to other end of needle **and attach LC.**

Page 83

Braided Bind Off in the Round

First of all, Nancy Bush's Book is Folk Knitting in Estonia (not Estonian)

Braid and Bind off round 3 (MC): carry the yarns across the front and bring the color to be used under the one just used; \*with MC p1, with CC k1, CC yarn to front and at same time bind off by passing the first stitch over the second stitch, **with MC, p1, bind off passing first st over second st**; rep from \* to end.

Page 98

**brk3tog** (a 2-stitch decrease) = brk1, place st back on left needle, pass following 2 stitches over, place finished st on right-hand needle.

## STITCH DICTIONARY

Page 110

Three-Color Stockinette Brioche Stitch

The color sequence is incorrect. This is the correct sequence:

Loosely CO an even number of sts in yarn A.

Set-Up Row (wS): with yarn B wyif, \*sl1yof, p1; rep from \*.

Row 1 (RS): bring yarn **C** to front and in front of hanging yarns, \*yf sl1yo, brk1; rep from \*.

Row 2 (WS): leaving yarns not being used in front and the yarn you are going to use behind, with yarn **A** yf, \*sl1yof, brp1; rep from \*.

Rep Rows 1–2 rotating yarn **B**, yarn **C** and yarn **A**.

Page 121

Twisted Brioche Stitch. You should loosely CO a multiple of **3 sts +2**.

Page 124: Plaited Brioche Stitch:

Set-Up Row 2: selv st, \*p1, **p the yo made in prev row and p the stitch under the yo**; rep from \*.

Photo on page 125

Doesn't correspond to the instructions. The photo should have been cropped so that the light pink part of both visuals is not shown.

Page 139

Half Brioche Feather Stitch

The chart has a few incorrect stitches but the written instructions are correct.

In Row 7, stitches 10 and 14 when counting from right to left should be a k st.

In Row 8, stitches 11 and 13 when counting from left to right should be a k st.

Page 142

Estonian Tuck Stitch and Two-Color Estonian Tuck Stitch.

The visuals are labeled incorrectly, the Right Side and Wrong Side should be switched.

Page 180

Before Row 18 (DS DC) Markers need to be added. Markers on sm/med size would be on sts 8, 98 and 105.

## PATTERNS

Page 179

Tulp Capelet

YOKE

Using smaller needle, DC and (**One-Color**) Long-Tail Cast On, CO 11 (15, 19) sts.

When told to place markers do so on the DS DC rows.

Row 12 should read:

Row 12 (DS DC): [work to marker, brkyobrk] twice, C9R, brkyobrk, work to marker, brkyobrk, C9L, brkyobrk, work to marker, brkyobrk, work to end, CO 4 sts—83 (87, 91) sts.

Reposition 1st, 3rd, and 5th markers to 1st brk of brkyobrk, and 2nd, 4th, and 6th markers to 2nd brk of brkyobrk.

Row 18: You need to place one marker toward each of the outside edges, leaving 9 sts inbetween the current outside edge markers (these 9 sts will be cables).

Page 192

Fiets Hand Shoes

After RDN 8 (B), Bind off like HAND.

Page 207

New Amsterdam Cardigan

Short Rows 19 **and 20** should read:

Short Rows 19: work to marker, sm, [brk1, allowing yo to slip off behind second st, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo] 6 times, brk1, k1.

Page 208

New Amsterdam Cardigan

Short Rows 19 **and 20** should read:

Short Rows 19: work to marker, sm, [yf, sl next st and wrap, yo, brk1, yf sl1yo, brk1] 6 times, yf sl1yo, k1.

Work even for **3** rows.

Page 211

Laars Manchetten

Reads:

RND 8 (DC): yf, \*[sl1wyib, ....

Should read:

RND 8 (DC): \*[sl1wyib, ....

RND 16 (DC): yf, \*[sl1yof, **brp1**] twice,...

Page 216

Rembrandt Neckpiece

After DEC ROW 2 D (RS) and you have 113 stitches rem., the next instruction should read:

**\*\*Work even for 6 working rows. rep Dec row 1 C and D—107 sts rem. Work even for 6 working rows. **Work Dec Row 2 C and D**. Rep from \*\* twice—79 sts rem. Work even for 6 working rows. Mark st columns 39, 45 and 55.**

Then the following instructions it should read:

Dec Row 3 c (RS): work to 2 sts before first marked column, dec2r, yf sl1, dec2l, work to 2 sts before next marked column, dec2r, work to 1 st before next marked column, **yfsl1**, dec2l, [work to 2 sts before next marked column, dec2r] twice, yf sl1, dec2l, work to end—72 sts rem.

Page 232

Waterlooplein Watch Cap

Gauge should read: **18** sts and 20 RS rows = 4" (10cm) in Rib Pattern

Page 247

The recommended yarn is a DK or light worsted weight yarn.

Haarlem Jacket, the largest size wasn't included in the instructions.

BACK

Note: The first portion of the cast-on will be worked with MC and A; the second portion will be worked with MC and MC2.

With Two-Color Italian Cast-On (see page 78-80), MC, and A, cast on 43 (49, 53, 59, **65**) sts, beg with MC, pm; drop A, and with MC and MC2, cast on 40 (40, 44, 44, **46**) more sts, beginning with MC2—83 (89, 97, 103, **111**) sts.
